## **HALF TERM PROJECT - Royal Mail's Heroes Stamp Design Competition**

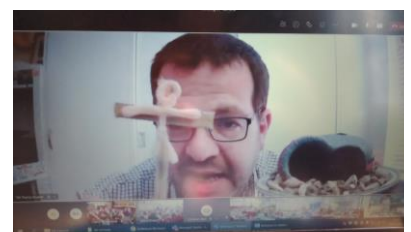
Our school is participating in this national art competition from Royal Mail to honour the heroes of the coronavirus pandemic.
