PTA BARBECUE AND PARTY IN THE PLAYGROUND! Look at the raffle prizes!



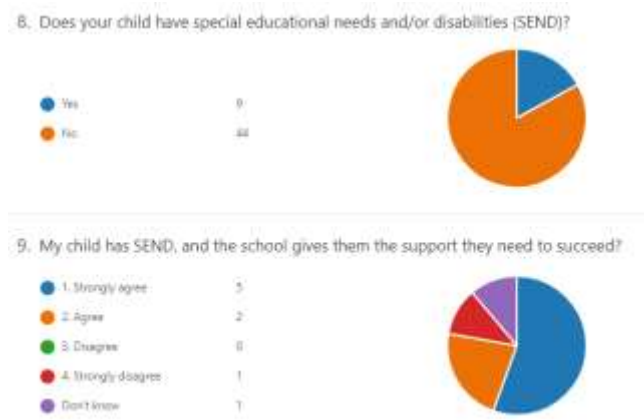
