HARVEST FESTIVAL: As usual at Whitchurch Primary School, we commemorate harvest festival with our annual donation to our local foodbank. From Monday 7th October crates will be in placed in our school foyer. Please donate food that is non-perishable (in a tin or packet with a lengthy sell by date) by placing in the crates. On Monday 14th the crates will be collected. We will also carry out an assembly on this day to explore the reasons behind a 'traditional' harvest festival, before bringing the message of giving up-to-date by looking at how food banks are so important, especially during the cost of living crisis.
