THE PTA ARE DRASTICALLY LOW ON VOLUNTEERS, AND ARE IN NEED OF HELP.

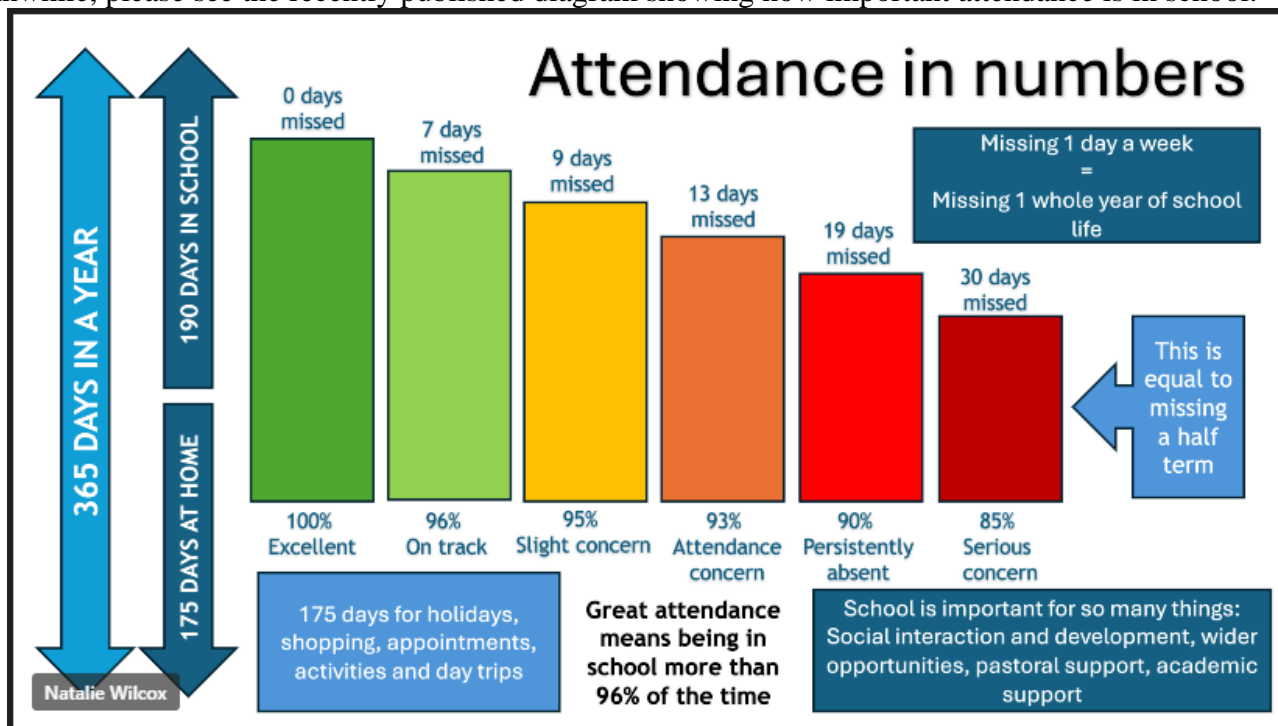
