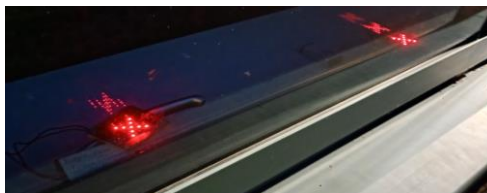
- Leaders and school staff are determined and committed to provide the very best education possible for the children.
